The Director of Nursing Services assumes 24-hour responsibility for the administration of nursing care to patients, and the management of nursing personnel, in the specific clinical areas, reporting to an Associate Chief Nursing Officer. This includes 7 Nurse Managers and their reports in Med/Surg, SICU, GI, BMTU, the Cancer Center and AOT units. They report to an Associate Chief Nursing Officer (ACNO).

Requirements

- Master Degree; Masters of Science in Nursing (MSN) or a Masters of Business Administration (MBA) preferred.
- Pennsylvania R.N. license, or immediate eligibility, and Basic Life Support Certification
- At least 5 years of related clinical experience including at least 3 years of managerial experience. An equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered.
- Demonstrated clinical competence in assigned area, knowledge and skill of professional nursing practice and theory, demonstrated leadership and administrative skills, knowledge of the Principles of learning and methods of teaching, budgetary management skills and excellent communication skills.
- Experience supervising in a union environment is preferred.
